

VAIDYARATNAM AYURVEDA COLLEGE, OLLUR

Vaidyaratnam Ayurveda College was founded by the late Ashtavaidyam E.T. Neelakandan Mooss on 2nd October 1976 and is under the management of Vaidyaratnam Ayurvedic Educational Society, registered under the Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act XII/1955. The College is affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences and offers B.A.M.S. degree (Ayurveda acharya). The course is recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicines (CCIM) and is of duration of 5½ years. P. G Course in Kayachikitsa was started with an intake capacity of 4 seat p.a from 2013 onwards. The College has a full fledged hospital with a bed strength of 120 which is sufficient for providing instructional and clinical facilities to the students. All the 14 teaching departments of the college are well equipped in respect of supporting facilities. The teachers are qualified as per norms of CCIM MSR. The College has got a good Library with additional department wise mini libraries. Computer and Internet facilities are available in College Library for study purpose of students. It has got a good Herbarium, X-ray unit and Ultrasonic scanner. Boys and Girls Hostels are available in the College Campus.

PROSPECTUS FOR BAMS COURSE

DURATION OF COURSE

The duration of course is 5 ½ years including compulsory internship for one year.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. On the basis of merit list as assessed in the national eligibility cum entrance test (NEET-UG) conducted by CBSE.
2. To be eligible for BAMS admission for a particular academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in NEET for the said academic year. However in respect of candidates belonging to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes, other backward castes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of the candidates with bench marked disabilities specified

under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for general category candidates and 40th percentile for SC/ST/OBC candidates. The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in the All India Common Merit List in NEET.

3. Candidates who have passed in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the Higher Secondary examination of the board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, with 50% marks in Biology separately, and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together, are eligible.

Admission Capacity: 50

SELECTION

The Entrance Commissioner will select candidates for 85% of seats and the remaining 15% seats are filled by the Management, i.e., 8 seats.

AGE

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age as on 31/12/2018. No age relaxation in the minimum age will be allowed.

APPROVALS

The course is approved by the Government of Kerala, the CCIM and AYUSH, the central Government Department for Indian systems of medicines. From 2010, the course is recognized by the Kerala University for Health Sciences.

- (c) Transfer certificate from the institution last attended and conduct certificate
- (d) Original mark list of the qualifying examination (higher secondary or equivalent) and the pass certificate of the qualifying examination

- (e) Eligibility certificate from any University in Kerala, in the case of candidates who have passed a qualifying examination other than Higher Secondary Examination / Vocational Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the Government of Kerala or the examination conducted by CBSE and CISCE
- (f) Migration Certificate
- (g) Physical fitness certificate in the relevant format given in Annexure xvii (a) or xvii (b) of the prospectus 2018
- (h) Data sheet of KEAM 2018
- (i) Stamp size photo - 1, Passport size photo - 1
- (j) Any other documents required by the head of institution.

Minimum marks for a pass

The student should get a minimum of 50% separately for theory, practical and oral examination in each subject to pass the subject.

Examination

The examinations are conducted by the Kerala University for Health Sciences and on successful completion of the course and internship the KUHS will issue the degree certificate.

Registration

On receiving the degree, the holder of the degree is eligible for registering as an A Class Registered Ayurveda Practitioner in T.C Medical Council or any other State Medical Council.
